Our diocese may be small, but we have a big vision for our future. It started back in 2013 at our diocesan synod when we started reflecting on the needs of our faith community. Two years later, Bishop Burns introduced a pastoral plan to successfully guide the Diocese of Juneau into the future. Since that time, we've implemented parts of the plan. There is still much work to accomplish. Work that requires significant planning and resources. Before we make any final decisions regarding the long-range plan for Diocese of Juneau, Fr. Pat Travers would like to hear from you.

You will all be asked to share your thoughts regarding our needs and the possibility of conducting a major fundraising effort in our diocese. Your feedback will enable us to determine potential support for the projects. If we, as a faith community, choose to move forward, the planning study will also provide us with information to identify prospective campaign leaders and to establish a realistic campaign goal.

Parishioners will have access to a fact sheet which details all our proposed needs and will be asked to respond in a variety of ways. Some parishioners will be personally interviewed, while others will have the option to mail in a survey or go online to answer questions.

The Steier Group, our development firm, will compile results from the study and present it to our diocese leadership. At that time, we will make an informed decision regarding the implementation of our master plan.

This process is extremely important. Each and every family in our diocese is encouraged to participate. Your input is valuable as we plan for the future of the Diocese of Juneau.
